

CARDIOGENIC SHOCK

Consider:

- Arrhythmia
- ALPACA
- MIS-C
- Viral Illness
- CHD
- Post-cardiac arrest
- Sepsis
- & many more...

Treat

- Judicious IVF
- Vasopressors including **dobutamine** and **milrinone**



OBSTRUCTIVE SHOCK

External compression of the heart

Pneumothorax
Hemothorax
Pericardial effusion
Cardiac tamponade
Pulmonary Embolism



HYPOVOLEMIC SHOCK

Hemorrhagic shock is most often from **trauma** and may require:

- ✓ Type and Cross
- ✓ Massive Transfusion Protocol
- ✓ Balanced Transfusions
- ✓ Advanced Imaging

NEUROGENIC SHOCK

- 1 Hypotension
- 2 Bradycardia
- 3 Peripheral Vasodilation



Start treatment with vasopressors and atropine.

Tachycardia

An early warning sign for shock.

Know age-appropriate vitals.

Normal HR for 12-18 is <100.
